Universalisation and Implementation of the Ottawa Convention (1997)







EU MA GENERAL OBJECTIVE

- To assist countries affected by landmines and unexploded ordnance
- To restore the conditions necessary for the security of their populations and their economic and social development: enhancing HUMAN SECURITY
- The EU "zero-victim target".











INTEGRATING MA INTO DEVELOPMENT

New Framework:

Guidelines on European Community Mine Action 2008 – 2013

Endorsed in November 2008 to ensure follow-up to the previous EC Mine-Action Strategy 2005- 2007.

Aims:

- 1. Provide synergy between security and development cooperation
- 2. Encourage the intergration of principles of *partnership* and *ownership* in mine action interventions.
- 3. Disseminate Best Practice.
